

What programs do students pursue at Jindal Global Law School (JGLS)?

Jindal Global Law School (JGLS), the flagship school of JGU, is the ranked #1 Private Law School in India. Established in **2009**, JGLS, which is recognized by the Bar Council of India offers:

What are the various ways to hire students from JGLS?

Recruiters may get involved in our Recruitment Drive in one or more of the following ways, based on their preference.

- a) **On-Campus Recruitment Event:** You may choose to participate in the **Annual On-Campus Recruitment Event** scheduled to take place in the month of **February 2018**.
- b) **Off-Campus / Recruitment on rolling basis:** You may request for student applications for potential hiring anytime during the year by providing the Career Office (CDPD) your pre-defined criteria based on which CDPD will screen & shortlist student profiles for your consideration.
- c) **Zero Day Hiring:** You may also participate in Zero Day event in which you can hire the candidates in advance (approximately 1 year before their graduation).
- d) **Assessment Internship:** In case the above proposed modes are not suited to your current requirements or preference, you may consider hiring students for assessment internships during summer internship (June & July) or during winter internship (December & January) whereby you can assess their candidature for possible hiring at your organization.

What time of the year is the Annual Campus Recruitment Event?

Jindal Global Law School organizes **Annual Campus Recruitment Event** in the month of **February** every year in which all kinds of organizations can participate and can assess students via interview. Exact dates can be checked by coordinating with CDPD team. You may also contact us to get a preferred slot and plan your visit accordingly.

What possible means are available for an organization wishing to hire JGLS students before or after the Campus Recruitment Event (Off-Campus)?

We understand that certain recruitment teams may not be able to visit our campus due to various reasons and keeping this in mind, we have kept an option for recruitment teams to participate in the Recruitment Event through below mentioned methods –

- Telephonic Interview
- Skype / video conferencing interview
- Interviews at your office location

What time of the year is Summer & Winter internships?

For internship, our students are available for a duration of 4-6 weeks during the below mentioned period:

Summer Internship – June & July

Winter Internship – December & January

How can I hire experienced candidates or Alumni?

To hire our experienced students or Alumni, you may share your requirements with CDPD Team and we will provide you with the list of relevant students' profiles for your consideration.

What are the typical steps in recruitment process?

Recruiter shares the JD with CDPD

CDPD shares the JD with students

Interested & Eligible students' profiles are sent to the Recruiter

Recruiter decides to visit OPJGU campus or Conduct an off-campus recruitment drive

Selection process may include Aptitude Test, Group Discussion, Case Analysis and Personal Interviews

The selected students are made the final offer to close the Campus Recruitment process

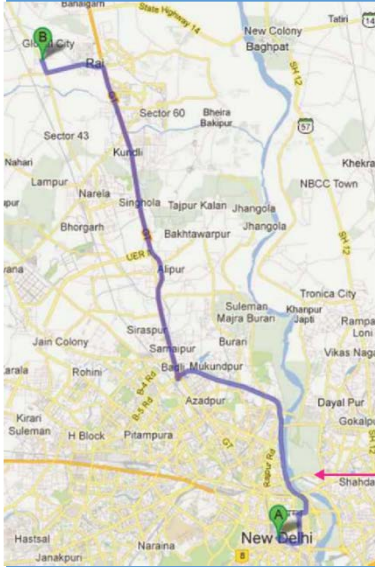

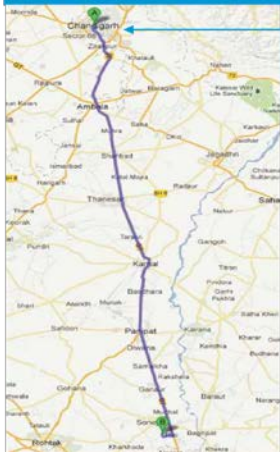

2. Head towards Yamuna Marg north on Mahatma Gandhi Rd/ Ring Rd
Continue to follow ring Rd
1. Continue onto Dr. KB Hedgewar Marg/Outer Ring Rd
Pass by Missionaries of Charity (on the left in 2.6 km)
1. Continue onto NH1 Pass by Batra Petrol Pump (on the left in 14.5 km)
1. Turn left from Beeswan Mill
2. Turn right

Chandigarh (A)

1. Head towards **Udyog Path**
2. Exit the roundabout onto **Udyog Path**
Go through 1 roundabout
3. At the roundabout, take the **3rd** exit onto **Sukhna Path**
Pass by Ballistics Lab Bus Stop (on the left in 850 m)
4. Turn left onto **Dakshin Marg**
Go through 3 roundabouts
Pass by Ordinance Cable Factory (on the left in 2.6 km)
5. Continue onto **NH 21**
Pass by Ambala, Karnal Panipat, Murthal
6. Turn right from **Beeswan Mill**
7. Turn right
