Associate Professor, adult and vocational education
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Dr. Sarojni Choy is Associate Professor of adult and vocational education at the Griffith University, where her responsibilities include teaching post graduate courses in adult and vocational education, and supervising postgraduate student research. Her research and writing activities focus on the foundations of adult learning, workplace learning, integration of learning in different sites, employment based training, continuing education and training, and workforce capacity building. She is the Program Director of Master of Training and Development offered off shore, and the Deputy Leader of the Professional and Practice Based Learning Research Group in the Griffith Institute for Educational Research. She has worked and lived in countries in South East Asia and the Pacific. Since 1994 she has worked and researched in the Australian vocational education and training sector as program manager, researcher and principal policy officer for the Commonwealth Government. Sarojni joined the higher education sector in 2005. She has led and managed leadership and workforce development programs to participants in Singapore, Indonesia, Thailand, Vietnam, Philippines and Papua New Guinea. Her current research projects focus on Enhancing the standing of vocational education and the occupations it serves; and Vocational Teachers' practices with integration of learning; and Modularisation and micro-credentialing to expand learner pathways.
